- Thank you for participating in this evening's Public Information Meeting on the Reconstruction of Charles Street between 25<sup>th</sup> Street and University Parkway. In order to help our analysis effort, do you have any Charles Street Reconstruction concerns beyond those presented or discussed tonight?

1. We should give up some median to create permanent on-street parking and permanent bike lane. The proposed 26' will encourage illegal driving and tells drivers to drive over the bicycle box. 18' is plenty for the medians.
2. Pedestrians need a crossing at 32nd and something needs to be done at 33rd. You found lots of peds at 32nd and 33rd, they need to be accommodated where they are.
3. We need 2 full-time NB lanes to accommodate transit, both current and future and to limit shifting traffic to Calvert (which should be 2-way.)
