I am a year-round bicycle commuter and student who uses Charles Street frequently. I can not stress enough the need for useful bike lanes. A 6 block bike lane that goes nowhere is a useless gesture. There needs to be a continuous, safe, and clearly marked (for cars and bikes alike) that goes north and south. Having a connected system of striped bike lanes is severely lacking in Baltimore and I have had several accidents which have all been directly or indirectly related to a lack of space on the road for bicycles. I support a permanent, striped bike lane.
